## Island Residents Questionnaire Results

The results are gathered from the 85 surveys that were returned.

1. How do you feel about allowing tourists to start visiting the island again?

• Strongly approve: 3 (3.5%)

• Approve: 20 (23.5%)

• Don't approve: 46 (54.2%)

• Not sure: 16 (18.8%)

2. Do you agree that tourism businesses (hotel/restaurant/B&B/self-catering cottages etc) on the island should be allowed to re-open on 15<sup>th</sup> July?

• Strongly agree: 5 (5.9%)

Agree: 32 (37.6%)Disagree: 16 (18.8%)

• Strongly disagree: 23 (27.1%)

• Not sure: 9 (10.6%)

3. Do you think that it would be possible to apply social distancing measures when tourists start visiting again?

Yes: 26 (30.6%)No: 35 (41.2%)

Not sure: 24 (28.2%)

- 4. At what stage do you think it is appropriate to start allowing tourists to visit again?
- Phase 1: Day trippers- 2 (2.4%), Short stay- 2 (2.4%)
- Phase 2: Day trippers- 5 (5.9%), Short stay- 18 (21.2%)
- Phase 3: Day trippers- 19 (22.4%), Short stay- 19 (22.4%)
- Phase 4: Day trippers- 44 (51.8%), Short stay- 38 (44.7%)
- Not sure: Day trippers- 15 (17.6%), Short stay- 8 (9.4%)

## **Summary of additional comments**

- Follow government guidelines
- Tourism really important for island economy. Worries that tourism on Gigha will never recover if we don't allow it this year
- Family members should be allowed
- Notices everywhere reminding of guidelines, face coverings

- Should have same rules as mainland, shouldn't be at a disadvantage for living on an island
- Ensuring people follow guidelines
- Have a plan in place for when tourists start visiting again
- Better safe than sorry
- Should only allow short stay tourists, no day trippers (very popular suggestion (although unsure how this would be possible))
- Concerns over toilet facilities
- Anxiety due to large numbers of elderly and vulnerable residents
- Matter for the Scottish government, not the trust
- Keep everyone safe and open up in 2021, although maybe extended family
- The fact that COVID is still killing people should be the guideline for not allowing tourists
- Have volunteers ensuring that social distancing is taking place
- Masks must be worn in public places
- Protect our vulnerable residents
- How to control the amount of tourists on island at one time
- Have 'rest days' for cleaning etc
- Staff equipped with PPE
- Hand sanitizer and PPE readily available
- Isolate Gigha, wait until vaccine
